Introduction:

1. We live in the age of instant information
2. Internet, cell phones, text messages, emails
3. We can spread information faster than ever before
4. And yet, when it comes to telling people about Jesus we sometime might as well be using two tin cans and a string or the Pony Express
5. Today, let's look at what we should go tell, to whom we should go tell and when we should tell it.

*READ PASSAGES and PRAY**

I. Go Tell What? (vv. 11, 17)

- A. The message of the angles
- B. Why? Because it is indeed "Good News"
- C. How? As eyewitnesses.

II. Go Tell Who? (v.18)

- A. All
- B. Why? Because it is indeed marvelous news
- C. Where? Everywhere we go.

III. Go Tell When? (v. 20)

- A. When we are excited
- B. When we are going about our daily business (returning to their flocks)
- C. Whenever an opportunity presents itself

2. Have you shared the Good News that Christ is born?
3. If not, why not?
